A Ringer from Illinois. The following was passed without a dissenting vote by the Illinois Christian Ministerial Institute, in session at Taylorville, Ill., April 25, 1895.

WHEREAS, There exist on the statute-books of our state special legislative acts by which the Roman Catholic bishop of Chicago is made a corporation sole, by virtue of which he is enabled to hold, sell, and convey, free of taxation, real estate without limit; and

WHEREAS, The said Roman Catholic bishop of Chicago does now hold in trust for the sole use of the Roman Catholic church between \$70,000,000 and \$100,000,000 worth of untaxable property; and

WHEREAS, The same legislature that granted these special favors to the said Roman Catholic church repealed an act by which the Episcopal bishop of Illinois was enabled to hold real estate for the benefit of the Episcopal church; and

WHEREAS, It is believed by this body that all or any special legislation favoring any ecclesiastical body is un-American, unjust, and to be deprecated; therefore, be it

Resolved, That this body does most heartily indorse the course of Col. Merriam, of the Thirty-ninth General Assembly of Illinois, in his untiring efforts to effect the repeal of this nefarious legislation.
