Among other things Doctor Miller is credited, by the World Herald; with using the following language:

"I have had occasion, Mr. Chairman, within the last twenty-four months to be ashamed that I was a citizen of Omaha. I discovered at about that time that a band of outlaws, calling themselves American citizens, had gathered together in dark chasms in this community and organized a band of conspiracy, tied to each other on the proposition that every citizen of this town who proposed to worship God according to communion of certain churches in our land should be ostracised from respectable standing, hunted down, as men not worthy of public trust, and driven out of society. I understand that that concern is here yet. [Laugh-ter.] But it will not be here much longer. I do not wish to be personal or disrespectful to any of my fellow towns-I know men are misled by secret mysteries, oaths and grips. I have been in the business myself.

I speak in soberness to my fellow P. O. or A. P. A., is it? I do not know what it means; but it is an infamous banded conspiracy against the decent people of this town of all parties. These itlemen have gone into this combination here under oath, and they violate the constitution every time they take them. The constitution itself expressly provides that the freedon of religion hall not be abridged. These men undertake to interpose between the souls of men and the Deity. I say they are not fit to be citizens of any community where men love liberty and know what American control is. [Applause.] "I desire to say in all candor that the
