Public Funds for Sectarian Schools.

TRUNTON, N. J., March 7.-The Catholic priests of the state have met here again with a view to making a second effort to secure the introduction of a bill attacking the state school funds in the interest of parochial schools. The set provides that it shall be lawful for any private school corporation to file with the state or any county superintendent, a certificate of incorporation, with a declaration of the willingness of the corporation to have the school used for a free public school. The county superintendent is then to appoint a president, secretary and treasurer of the corporation as a board of school trustees. Such shools shall be subject to the general school laws of the state, and all teachers shall have regular school certificates; the school trustees to make reports of the number of pupils attending these additional 'free public schools," as the act calls them; to the state school superintendent, and on the basis of the census the state is to assign out of its school fund to such additional "free public schools" the same money per child that it cost the state in the preceding year for each child within school age in the public schools in the state.
