Robert Browning, the greatest English poet of the age, died a few days ago.

The annual session of the Nebraska Editorial Association will be held at Kearney on January 23rd and 24th.

Omaha will make an effort to get the location of the state fair for the next five years, the term for which it was located at Lincoln having expired.

The recommendation of Judson Graves for postmaster at Neligh has called forth a set of resolutions by the Antelope farmers alliance, which were published in the Omaha Bee a few days ago.

The trial of Dr. Kelly, superintendent of the insane hospital at Norfolk, closed last Saturday. The jury were out about five hours and returned a verdict of not guilty.

On last Monday afternoon the great Cronin trial at Chicago came to an end. The jury, after being out nearly sixty hours, having agreed on a verdict, which sends Coughlin, O'Sullivan and Burke to the penitentiary for life.
