Hull, the democratic, assistant-gang candidate, has commenced a number of suits within the past year, but none have been kept in court and brought to trial; H. T. Conley, the republican nominee, has a larger law practice than all the other attorneys in the county combined, and at the last term of the district court he won every case in which he appeared, which came to trial. It is about time that Sioux county had a county attorney who is willing and competent to look after the interests of the county as they should be, and the election of H. T. Conley will insure such results.

The gang organ is filled with all sorts of charges and cracks without any foundation in fact. The few of the old gang who remain realize that it is a desperate battle they have to fight. They know that if they do not succeed in getting some one whom they can "work" into the county offices to be filled this year that it will be decidedly unpleasant for them. They know that if Conley is elected county attorney he will prosecute violations of the law and that his papers and court work will be such that it will hold. They know that a number of the old gang do not desire to go into court to answer for their past action. They escaped on the 9th of January, 1890, by a close shave from being taken in hand by the people, and at the spring term of the district court they dodged a grand jury on a technicality. Davis has never had any experience in the practice of law and Hull has established a reputation for not being able to keep a case in court, even if he has to withdraw the suit, as he did in the case of the salary matter against Walker. The gang does not want Wilcox elected because he would work for the interests of the county and not for the interests of the gang. To get fellows in office that can be controlled by the gang has been the end they have worked for. The democrats put Hull on for county attorney and Koorath for commissioner in the hope that it would assist in defeating Conley and Wilcox. Hull will get few votes and the plan was to catch the German vote by putting Koorath up for commissioner. The plan shows the work of Batteries and in order to still more add to the effect on the Germans they put L. Gerlach and Charles Biehle on their central committee. The former declines to be a public card and it is well known that the latter is not a democrat. The voters are onto the little game of the gang, and will defeat their scheme and elect their candidates for county attorney.

The building formerly occupied by E. M. Carrier as a blacksmith shop has been removed to G. Guthrie's lots, and H. A. Cunningham will soon begin the erection of a new business building on the lot thus vacated.

Henry Diester, a resident of the north part of the county, died near Hill City, S. D., a short time ago, of mountain fever. Mrs. Diester was also sick at the time and could not get up from her bed to attend his wants. The family have returned to the vicinity of their home, and have the sympathy of all who learn of their sad loss.

The damage case of Hull against the county commissioners and their bondsmen is out of court. At the last session of district court here Mr. Hull was given fifteen days in which to file an amended petition. A paper was filed before the expiration of the fifteen days. It was verified by L. O. Hull, but is signed by no one. It says "comes from the above named plaintiff, Lorenzo O. Hull, by W. H. Westover, his attorney," but there is no signature to the document. The paper is in the handwriting of A. W. Crites, but that gentleman has evidently tired of Hull's cases as he scratched his name out as an attorney in the case. Thus ends Mr. Hull's vision of \$5,000.00 damages.

On last Friday a suit was brought in the county court by S. A. Beers against Jacob Henry, for damage done to the crops of the former by the stock of the latter. There was no contest as to the damage having been done or the amount claimed, but the defendant set up the plea that the herd law was inoperative in Sioux county, and that free range was the law. The court decided that herd law was in force in Sioux county and gave judgment for the plaintiff. That is one decision on that point. Several cases have been brought where that point might have been raised, but
