The eminent Dr. Chiappoli states that he has frequently noticed ir, patients. apparently very far from deat h, an extraord inary opening of the eyel ids, so much so as to give the eyes an a ppearance of protrading from their orbits, which he considers an invariable sign that death will occur within twenty-four hours. In some cases, when only one eye is wide open while the other romains normal, death will not follow quite so rapidly. but will take place within seventy-two hours, there being not the slightest chance for recovery after these symptoms set in, however remote final dissolution may seem to be. Chiappoli says he is atterly at a loss for an explanation of this death symptom, but ascribes it to a diseased state of the sympathetic nerve.




