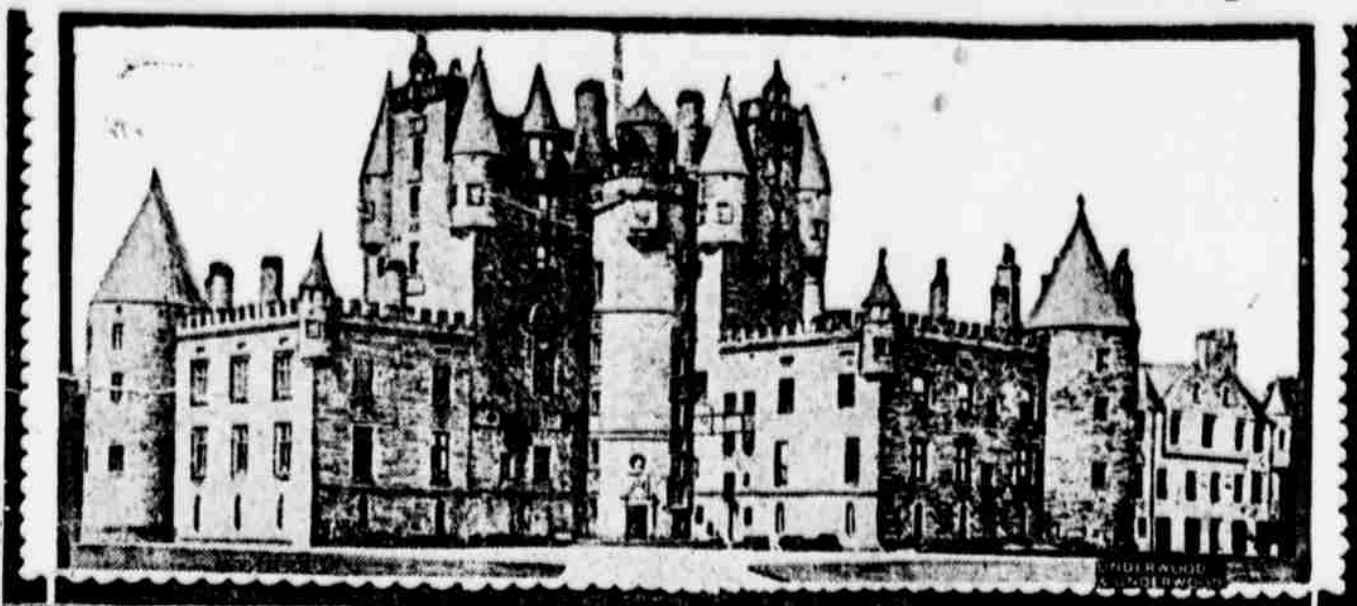

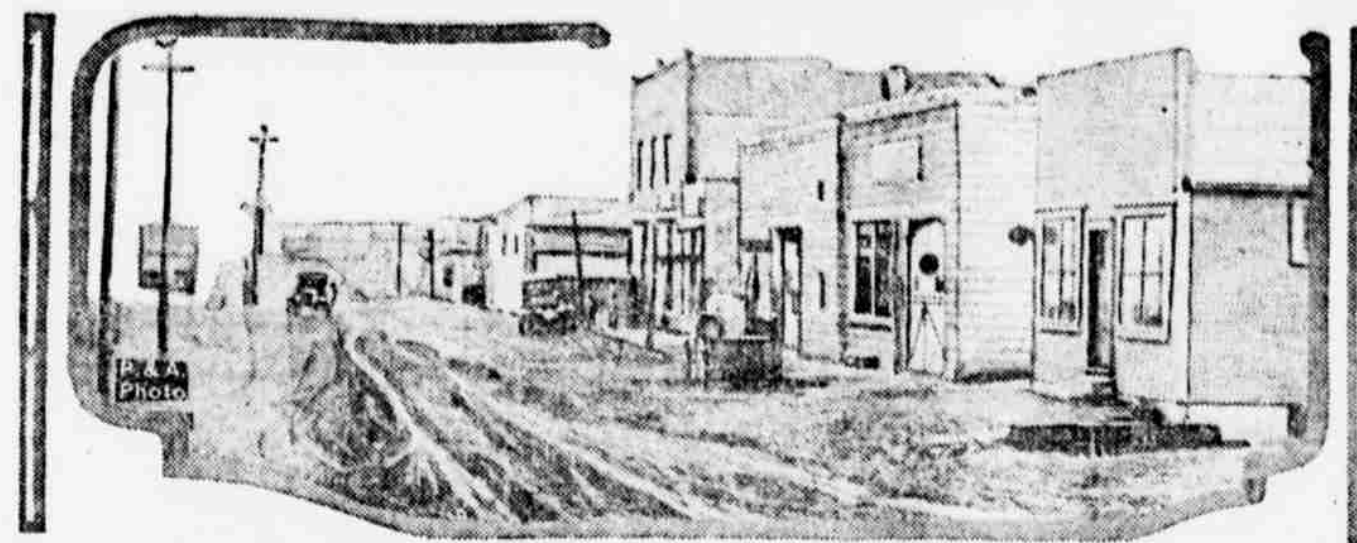

Stevenson's Warning.

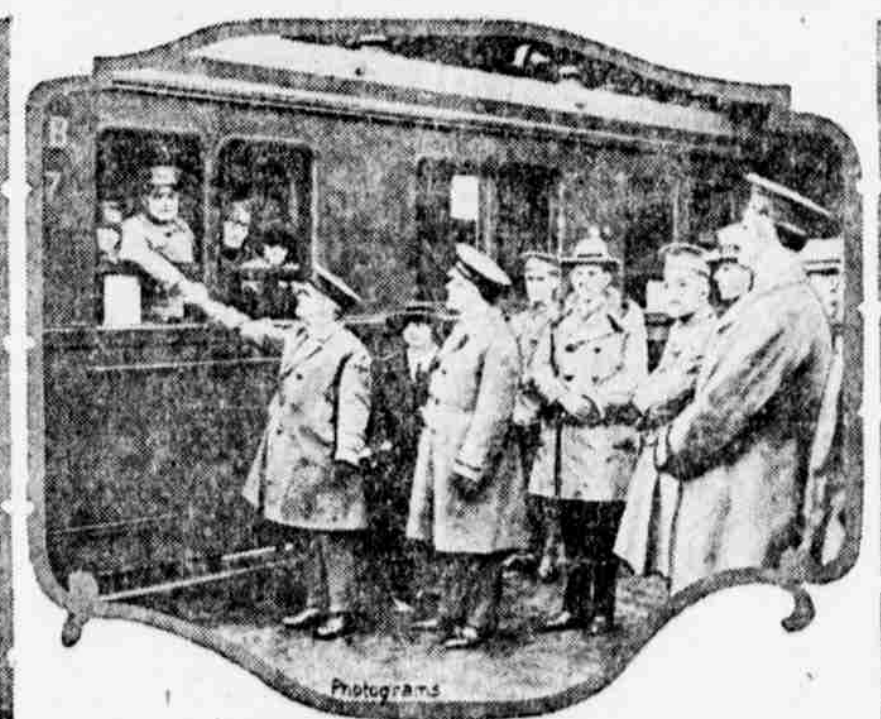

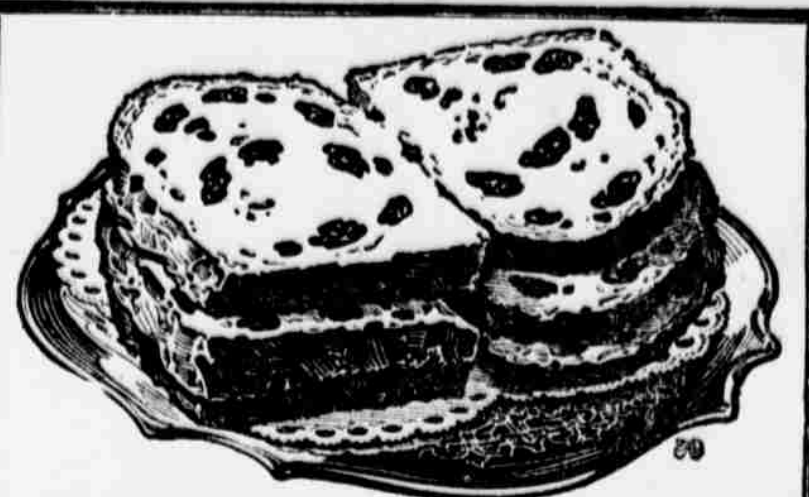
Salvation Army Leaves for Home

TAKEN FROM EXCHANGES

The output of magnesia for metallurgical industries is declining. Trotsky, the bolshevist leader, is the son of a Jewish chemist, his real name being Leiba Bronstein. The commonest of all place-names in England is Newton, which occurs no fewer than 72 times in different parts of the country. The government census taken January 1, 1920, showed that the horse family has achieved a comeback, for it disclosed that there were 2,083,861 horses and mules at work in the cities, towns and villages of the country. Some of the earliest of the fresh vegetables that reach snow-bound American markets come from the Isle of Pines, which was once notorious as a rendezvous for Caribbean pirates. The value of the bean crop in the United States is about \$100,000,000. The Egyptians sometimes used stones 30 feet in length in their masonry. Eight popes have been named Urban, the first of them holding that position from 222 to 230. The longest wave measured by officers of the United States hydrographic service was half a mile, and it did not spend itself for twenty-three seconds. The colleges of this country have expended on each engineering graduate from \$800 to \$2,000 above all fees received. Private Raymond O. Coulter, aged twenty-two, of Mount Sterling, Ill., member of the United States Marine corps, is known as the wonder shot of the world. Coulter holds a rifle record of 206 out of 300.

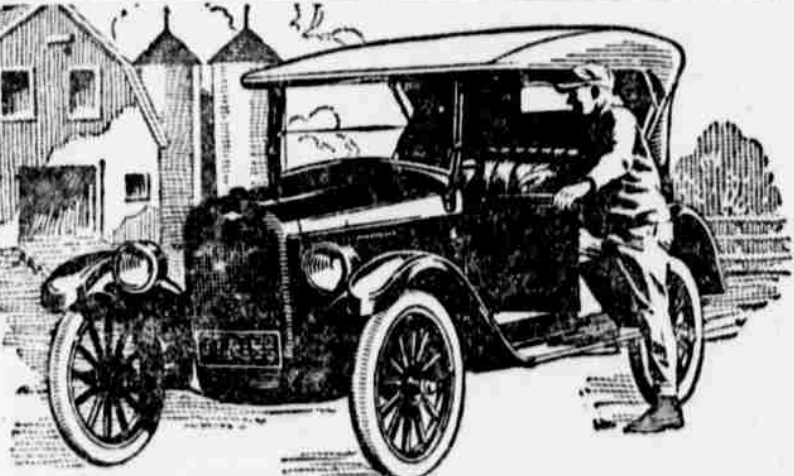
