Receipts were fairly liberal again today, about 7,600 head, making an increase so far this week of about 4,000 head over the week ending last week.

RECEIPTS—HOGS

Receipts were steady and heavy today, about 15,500 head, making an increase so far this week of about 3,000 head over the week ending last week.

RECEIPTS—SHEEP

Receipts were about 7,000 head, making an increase so far this week of about 1,000 head over the week ending last week.

The week the total is only 23,300 head, being more than 3,000 smaller than a week ago, 4,000 lighter than two weeks ago and 1,000 short of the corresponding days of last year.

Continued moderate supplies and encouraging advices from other markets forced an upward in local values today. The market opened out in good season at a full dime advance, and by the time the bulk of the offerings started to move prices had looked a flat 10c above yesterday.

As compared with the size of total receipts the supply of ewes was fairly large, but the outlet continued broad, and most of the offerings sold by the middle of the forenoon at about 12c higher prices.
