rewarned is to be forearmed. Insect sts are not such a terrible thing to the man who understands how to cure cir attacks.

The most approved means of conling insects consists in the use of onous mixtures in liquid or drywder form. Insects desiroy plants by cking out their juices, or by eating the liage or stems. If they suck the juices the plant we must kill them by conct, as they sink their beaks into the sues of the plants and do not take up ny poison which might be sprayed on foliage. If they chew the foliage or ns. we can kill them by applying to foliage a poison which when eaten Il kill them; hence we have the two nds of poison, contact and internal. e contact poisons are also of two kinds ose which kill by corroding or eating their bodies, and the powders that by filling up the breathing pores, h in most hard-bodied insects with which we have to deal, are located on the surface of the body.-Mothers' Magazine.

Under the caption of "The Effect of War Upon Women" in the annual issue ucational advertising—the people make an of the publication of the American Sociological society she says:

"Women are made relatively plenty. and therefore cheap as women. It may be that in more primitive times such a situation would be a cause of polygamy. In our day it will mean a vast overplus of women. They will be a 'drug on the market,' while men will return from war not only with their importance enhanced by the glory of the battelfield, but with a scarcity value. So far as this effect is realized, women, who in many ways 'do not count' new, will 'count' still less hereafter.

"A second effect is that women, being more necessary, become more important instead of less. Everywhere they are being admitted into, or drawn or forced into, new lines of activity and into work from which they were formerly debarred


