Price of Raw Sugar Continues to Climb

NEW YORK, March 16.-The continued rong tone of the raw sugar market today sent the price of granulated sugar to the highest level recorded since the outbreak of the European war. One of the largest American refiners quoted the granulated product at 7 cents while others advanced the price to 6.90 cents. The high price was attributed to the recent active demand for sugar from abroad, owing to the small European acreage of beet sugar and large domestic buying. HARNEY 937--1060
