## ZERO WEATHER IN MOST OF THE STATE

Good Snowfall Also Comes to Delight the Hearts of the Farmers.

### WEATHER SOON CLEARED UP

According to the morning weather reports to the railroads, the Missouri valley, especially that portion in the vicinity of Omaha, was the banana belt of the central section of the country Thursday and during the night. At no place in the valley, according to these reports, did the temperature touch zero, though out in the state in many localities it went far below, the night being recorded as the coldest since last winter.

So far as Nebraska was concerned, Ericson was the banner spot for cold. There during the night the mercury went down to 4 degrees below zero, with Curtis, Madrid and Sidney reporting 4 below. It was 2 below at Randolph, with numerous places reporting zero. Generally out in the state the readings reported to the railroads were 2 to 10 above zero.

The weather out in the state cleared during the night and this morning everywhere it was clear, calm and cold. During a greater portion of Wednesday snow was general over the state, accompanied by some wind, but not enough so that the drifting interfered with traffic.

All along the Upper Pacific, from Fremont to beyond North Platte, the snowfall Thursday ranged from four to six inches, making pretty fair sleighing. Up through the Northwestern country, into South Dakota and out into Wyoming there was about the same amount of snow, while south along the Burlington lines it was a little lighter, with a silt heavier fall through eastern Colorado and northern Kansas.

Between Benkelman and Denver the snow was eight to ten inches of snow and four to eight inches over most of the St. Francis branch in Kansas.
