### MRS. BENNER PAID BILLS FOR HUBBY

So Testifies Mrs. Edith Taylor in Divorce Suit of Mrs. Theodora Van Wyck Benner.

### CASE IS PENDING IN OMAHA

Depositions taken in New York in behalf of Mrs. Happy Theodora Van Wyck Benner in her divorce suit against Fernando W. Benner, New York real estate dealer, have arrived in the office of the clerk of the district court.

Mrs. Benner, who is the daughter of the late Charles Van Wyck of Nebraska City, former United States Senator from Nebraska, and who is well known in social circles of New York City, has accused her husband of non-support and extreme cruelty and in the depositions four witnesses give testimony which supports her charges.

Miss Louise Taylor, 43 West Sixtieth street, a singer, who met Mr. and Mrs. Benner at Carlton Terrace, two years ago, testified that "it was enough for Mrs. Benner to make a statement for Mr. Benner to contradict it or criticize it or ridicule it."

Excessively Discourteous. She described Mr. Benner's treatment of Mrs. Benner as "excessively discourteous."

Mrs. Edith L. Tyler, an intimate friend of Mrs. Benner, who was frequently in her company, testified in a deposition that Mrs. Benner paid her own bills and Mr. Benner's bills.

"Mrs. Benner even had to pay Mr. Benner's laundry bills," said the witness, "and when she was away, he had supper parties and ran up grocery and wine bills."

Mr. Benner made fun of Mrs. Benner, Mrs. Tyler testified.

Archibald Shaw, principal of a boys' school which Van Wyck, the 33-year-old son of Mr. and Mrs. Benner attended, testified that it was Mrs. Benner who paid the bills for his tuition.

Maintained Own Car. William M. Haradon, a garage proprietor, said Mrs. Benner maintained a car at her expense at his garage.

Mr. and Mrs. Benner were married in New York, October 30, 1903, the wedding being a notable social event.

In 1908 Mrs. Benner started a suit for divorce but dismissed it, July 12, last, she brought suit again in Omaha. In an answer filed September 13, Mr. Benner denied her charges, asserting that such differences as they had had were merely the usual disputes between married folks and that they had never had a serious quarrel. Although not wealthy, he said, he was able and willing to support his wife.

### Chief Dunn is to Sing at Municipal Christmas Tree

Henry W. Dunn, chief of police, has consented to sing next Thursday evening at the municipal Christmas tree celebration to be held in the Auditorium. Mr. Dunn has been active in musical affairs in connection with the Ak-Sar-Ben den initiatives.

The celebration is being arranged by City Commissioner Butler and Eunice Emory, supervisor of extension work in the public schools. The Omaha Musicians' association will furnish a band. After the program and distribution to the children the floor will be cleared for dancing by the young people.
