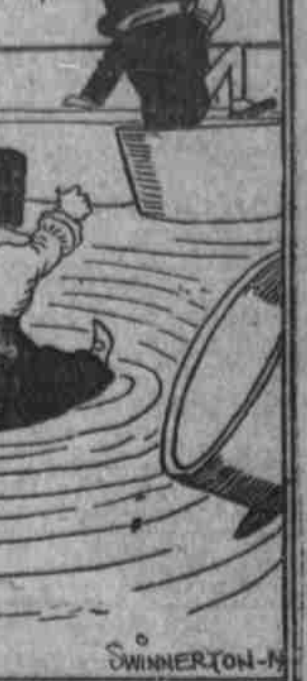

NARVESON KNOCKS IN ALL LINK RUNS

Pitcher Wins Own Game from Bourkes by Founding in All Six Runs.

HOMER WITH SACKS LOADED

Lincoln, June 13.—(Special Telegram.)

On Narveson, the Lincoln pitcher, hampered by all six of Lincoln's runs and was his own game from Omaha this afternoon, 6 to 1, Narveson crossed Manager Krug twice when the latter gave instructions to Pitcher Hallman.

In Lincoln's half of the second, McIntyre walked and Schreiber doubled to the left field fence and Lloyd lined out to Whalen, who made a pretty catch.

Krug then told Hallman to pass Catcher Yantis to get at Narveson.

With the bases filled and two strikes and three balls called on him, Narveson whalloped the next ball far over the left field fence for a homer and four runs centered in. Narveson scored Lloyd from second in the fourth, after having two strikes called on him with a stringing single to center.

Sends in Ninth Run. The Lincoln pitcher sent in the sixth run when Schreiber and Lloyd singled, advanced on a sacrifice, and Schreiber scored when Narveson hit so hotly to Whalen that the ball could not be handled to stop the runner at home.

Omaha's first two runs came in the fourth. Thomson walked and then Krug drove one to the center field fence for a triple. Krug scored on Schreiber's single to right. In the eighth the Bourkes were dangerous and threatened to tie the score. Forsythe singled to center. Krueger followed with another safe blow to the same place, and after Krug and Thomson had been put down, Schreiber followed with a safe blow over the left field fence.

Krug was put in as a pinch hitter in the ninth, but fanned. Brown drove a hot single to left, but Narveson handled Forsythe's grounder.
