Comment of Press of United States On Sinking of Arabic

Chicago Journal: The sinking of the Arabic is exactly the same sort of piracy as the sinking of the Lusitania with the added aggravation of being needless.

Whether the American government should break off diplomatic relations with Germany over this occurrence is a question that must be decided by President Wilson and Secretary Lansing, not by any newspaper. But, frankly the Journal can see no use in arguing about neutral rights and humane duties with the Hohenzollern court.

Indianapolis News: The question is not whether American lives were lost—though that would aggravate the offense—but whether they were "put in jeopardy by the sinking of the Arabic. The questions to be determined are whether the Arabic was torpedoed without warning and whether the Arabic itself received summons to stop and refuse to heed it.

Indianapolis Star: Judgment will have to be withheld until the full details of the sinking of the Arabic become known, but there is no question that a grave crisis confronts the United States if American citizens lost their lives on the ill-fated vessel.

Portland Oregonian: The attack on the Arabic is a challenge, definite and defiant, to President Wilson to follow his words with deeds. It is, or will be, incumbent upon the United States to stand by its own interpretation of neutral rights, whatever the cost, or to back up with whatever the cost.

The Pueblo (Colo.) Chieflain points out that the Arabic on its trip from New York to England, carried war munitions and says: "It would be unreasonable to expect the German naval commanders to give free passage to a ship westbound when the same ship was serving as a war-cargo carrier on the eastbound trip."

The Chieflain does not regard the loss of the Arabic as ground "for a break with Germany, much less war."

UNBELIEVABLE HORRORS PERPETRATED BY TURKS

LONDON, Aug. 20.—A Reuter dispatch from Petrograd says: "Almost unbelievable details of Turkish massacres of Armenians in Bitlis have reached Petrograd. In one village 1,000 men, women and children are reported to have been locked in a wooden building and burned to death."

"In another large village only thirty-six persons, it is said, escaped massacre. In still another instance, it is asserted that several scores of men and women were tied together by chains and thrown into Lake Van."

New Churches at Burwell. BURWELL, Neb., Aug. 20.—(Special.)—More than ordinary interest is being taken in church matters in Burwell at the present time. The new \$10,000 Catholic church is well under way and will be completed within the next two months, and will then accommodate the growing congregation.

The congregational church people began Monday morning to tear down their present church building, a part of which is the oldest building in Burwell, and will erect a new \$10,000 pressed brick building on the present site. It will be ready for occupancy by the beginning of the new year.
