Food Commissioner Harman Brings Action Against Various Drug Firms of Lincoln.

TEST OF LAW ON MISBRANDING
(LINCOLN, Aug. 29.—Special.)—Rights of patent medicine manufacturers or dealers to sell or keep for sale any article containing on the label the word "cure" will be decided by a case in justice court in Lancaster county.

Commissioner Harman has been going after numerous manufacturers for using the word "cure" insisting that they have no right to use the name unless it really cures and that it is only another infringement of the law against misbranding.

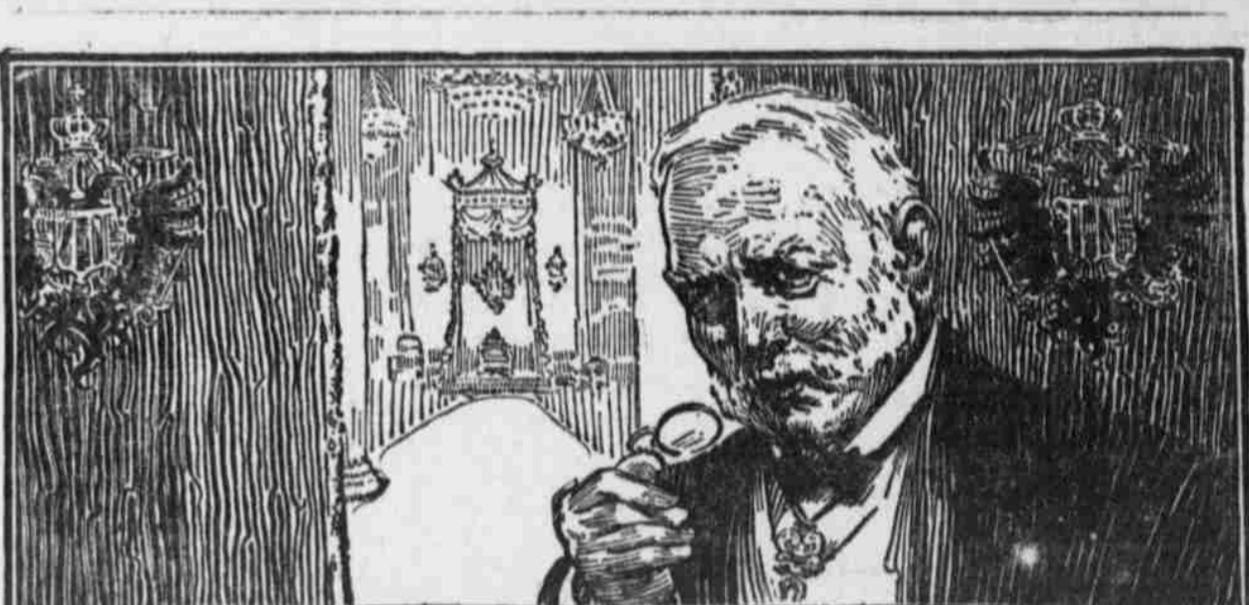
