The gist of the complaint is in this paragraph: "Such a high-handed, biased and ill-advised action on the part of the Commercial club of Omaha as this refusal to give a hearing to the progressive party legislative candidates lends color and support to the widespread suspicion that the Commercial club is controlled by an inner coterie of silk-stockings gentry, who are contemptuous of the needs and ideas of the ordinary citizen."
