BATTLE OF YSER

Both Allies and Germans Report Progress in Bloody Struggle on Canal.

FRENCH ATTACK ON OLD LINE. Take Offensive After Withdrawal of German Troops and North of Soissons Have Better of Artillery Duel.

BULLETIN. PARIS, Oct. 28.—A very brief official statement was issued tonight by the French war office regarding the great battle which is in progress in Belgium and northern France.

There is nothing to report except some progress on our part in the region to the south of Dixmude. BERLIN (via Amsterdam and London), Oct. 28.—General headquarters under date of October 27 announces: "The battle on the Yser canal near Ypres and southwesterly from Lille is proceeding with the same stubbornness. Yesterday the German troops made progress.

"On the other battle front in the western theater no important events have occurred. "To the west of Augustown the attack of the Germans is slowly proceeding. To the southwest of Warsaw our troops have repulsed all attacks of strong Russian forces. Noth of Ivangorod a new Russian army corps has crossed the Vistula."

GERMANS REAR PORTS. LONDON, Oct. 28.—The German raid on the channel ports, as it is called here, seems to have been checked for the time being, or at any rate, the Germans have made little if any progress since they succeeded in crossing the Yser canal on Saturday last. They are, however, still pushing with all the forces at their command and are meeting with most stubborn resistance from French, British and Belgian troops.

The losses on both sides continue to be in proportion to the fierceness of the battle, which means that they are greater than those in any battle since war was declared now nearly three months ago.

Along the coast, where the allies have the assistance of French and British warships, they have apparently more than held their own, and after inflicting very heavy losses on the Germans have compelled them to try for an opening further inland. Up until yesterday the allies had been forced to give way at some points, but today, according to the French official communication, they have succeeded in holding their positions at every point from the mouth of the Yser to the Lens district, and again have advanced between Ypres and Roulers, where there has been some of the sternest fighting of this sanguinary battle and where the British Indian troops have made their appearance on the firing line.

The opposing forces are so strong that it must be many days before a decisive result is attained by either side, despite the heavy losses they are suffering and which grow greater as report follows report.

French Busy on Old Front. Along the old front, stretching from the river Oise to the Meuse, from which the Germans withdrew their best troops to strengthen the army which is attempting to advance along the coast, the French have taken the offensive, and to the north of the Soissons have been engaging in an artillery duel with the Germans in which their heavy destroyed several of the German batteries. The Germans are now playing at this game for some time, for the last three reports from Paris have announced the destruction of German guns.

WASHINGTON, Oct. 28.—Comptroller of the Currency Williams tonight made public statements showing the reserve held by the national banks in the twelve federal reserve districts on the date of his last call for their condition, the reserves required under the present national banking act and those in excess of the amounts required by the federal reserve act.

According to his figures, the reserves held September 12, were \$30,000,000 in excess of the amount required under the law. Of this vast sum \$3,000,000 was in Boston districts, \$8,000,000 in New York; \$7,000,000 in Philadelphia, \$3,000,000 in Cleveland, \$2,000,000 in Richmond, \$14,000,000 in St. Louis, \$3,000,000 in Minneapolis, \$7,000,000 in Kansas City, \$2,000,000 in Dallas and \$3,000,000 in San Francisco.

The statement shows that on September 12 the reserve of all national banks was about \$15,000,000 above legal requirements. Another statement sets forth that present reserve requirements are \$1,600,711,368; that the new requirements will be \$288,752,809; and that consequently \$464,919,076 in reserves will be released under the new law. Of this amount New York City will contribute about \$58,000,000, Chicago about \$24,000,000, St. Louis about \$1,000,000 and other reserve cities about \$33,000,000 and country banks about \$141,000,000.
