Four Congressional Districts Still Uncertain, According to Latest Returns.

SENATE STAYS BOURBON BY 14

Colorado, Wisconsin and Nevada Elections for Representatives to Upper Body Are Not Settled.

NEW YORK, Nov. 5.—With four congressional districts still uncertain, results of Tuesday's elections show that the democrats elected to the house 235; republicans, 101; independent, 1. This would give the democrats a majority in the lower house of the 67th congress.

Majority of Fourteen. This result, if carried out, would make the representation in the next senate fifty-five democrats, forty republicans and one progressive democratic majority of fourteen.
