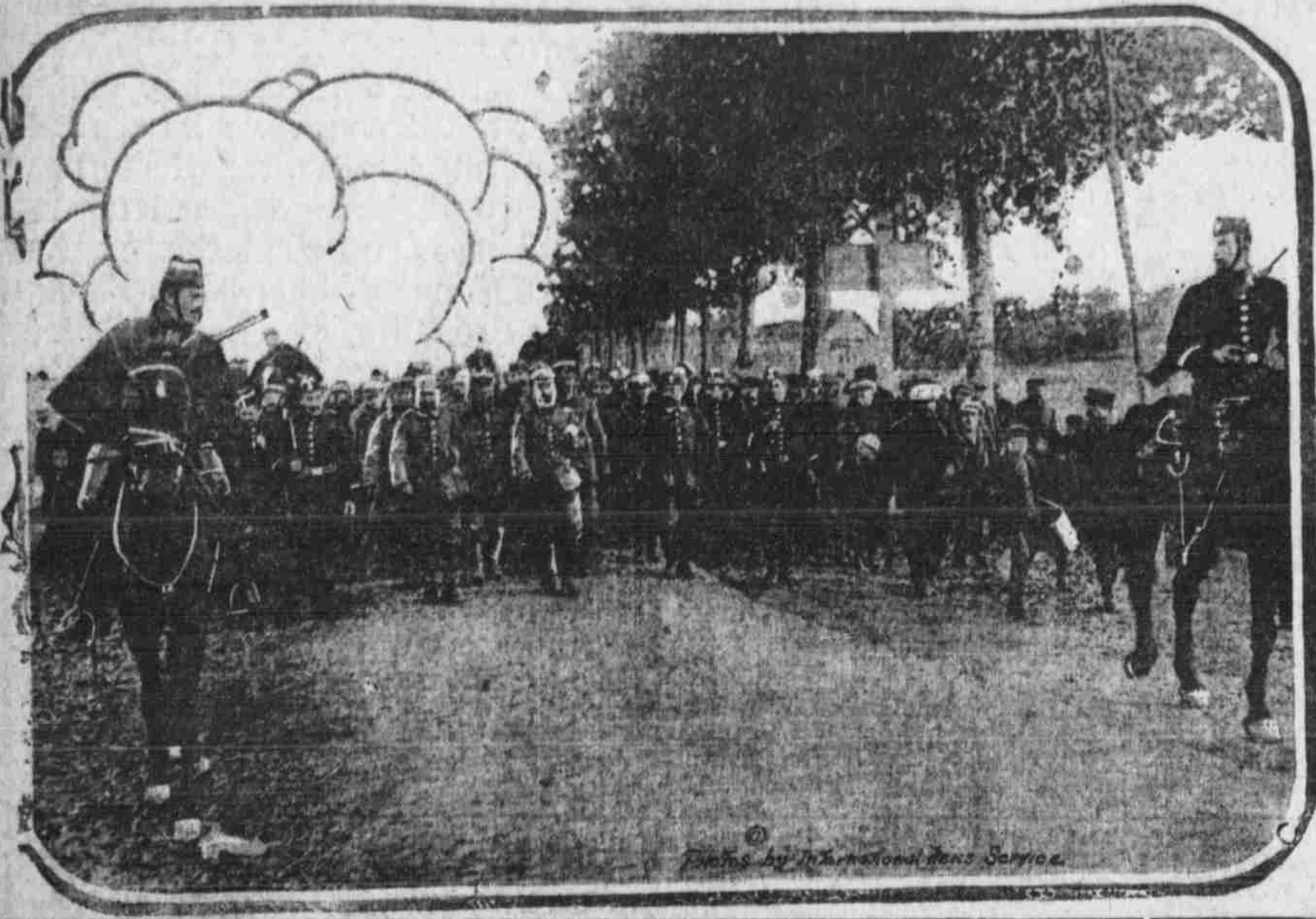

ISLANDER TELLS OF EMDEN'S FIGHT

German Cruiser Surprised by Sydney While Party Attacking British Insular Station.

LEAVES BOAT CREW BEHIND

Hostile Craft Starts in Pursuit of the Fleeing Tendon, and Both Exchange Shots—Britons Have Speed Advantage.

(The following story is the description of the opening of the battle between the German cruiser Emden and the Australian cruiser Sydney by an eye witness.)

One of the islands is known as Ocean Island, and there the Eastern Telegraph company has a cable station and staff engaged in relaying messages between England and Australia.

The war seemed very far away. Official bulletins passed through the cable station, but they contained little news and the only excitement was when it was rumored that the company was being hit in case of a raid on the station.

Cruiser Arrives. At 5 a. m. on Monday a four-funnelled cruiser arrived, full speed, at the entrance to the lagoon.

Turn Out Operators. The Germans, for all doubt as to the identity of the mysterious cruiser now was at an end, at once rushed up to the cable station and turned out the operators, smashed their instruments and seized guns all over the buildings.

While the cable station was being put out of action the crew of the launch grappled the cables and endeavored to cut them, but fortunately without success.

Passes from Sight. So the great naval duel passed from our sight and we could turn our attention to the portion of the German crew that had been left behind.

On relating they lined up on the shore of the lagoon, evidently determined to fight to a finish if the British cruiser sent a party ashore, but at 8 p. m. the German raiders embarked on the old schooner Ayesa, which belongs to Mr. Ross.

Details of Battle. Early the next morning, Tuesday, we saw the Sydney returning, and at 8:45 a. m. it anchored off the island.

Only two German shots proved effective. One Kowitch failed to explode, but smashed the main range finder and killed one man.

The Sydney left here at 11 a. m. on Tuesday in hope of picking up any of the survivors of the Burook, the collier that had been in attendance on the Emden and was sunk after the engagement on the previous day.
