

Burlington Makes Some Changes in Its Passenger Schedule

Effective one week from Sunday the Burlington will put on a new schedule that will have considerable bearing on its train service through Nebraska, Iowa and Colorado.

Train No. 9, that reaches Omaha from Chicago at 11:35 at night, will be designated as No. 1, carrying No. 1's equipment, and will arrive here at midnight.

at 7:05 o'clock. The Kansas City train, No. 22, will leave Omaha at 11:05, instead of 10:45 in the evening, as now.

The discontinuing of Nos. 1 and 19 is in accordance with the rearrangement of the winter schedule. While travel has been fairly good all fall, it is apparent that the California business is not going to be as heavy as during former years, and to meet the conditions the road proposes to do a little retrenchment.

The new schedule probably contemplates all the changes that will be made during the winter, at least so far as the discontinuance of trains is concerned. On the branch lines and on the lines to the northwest, the minimum service has been the rule for many months.
