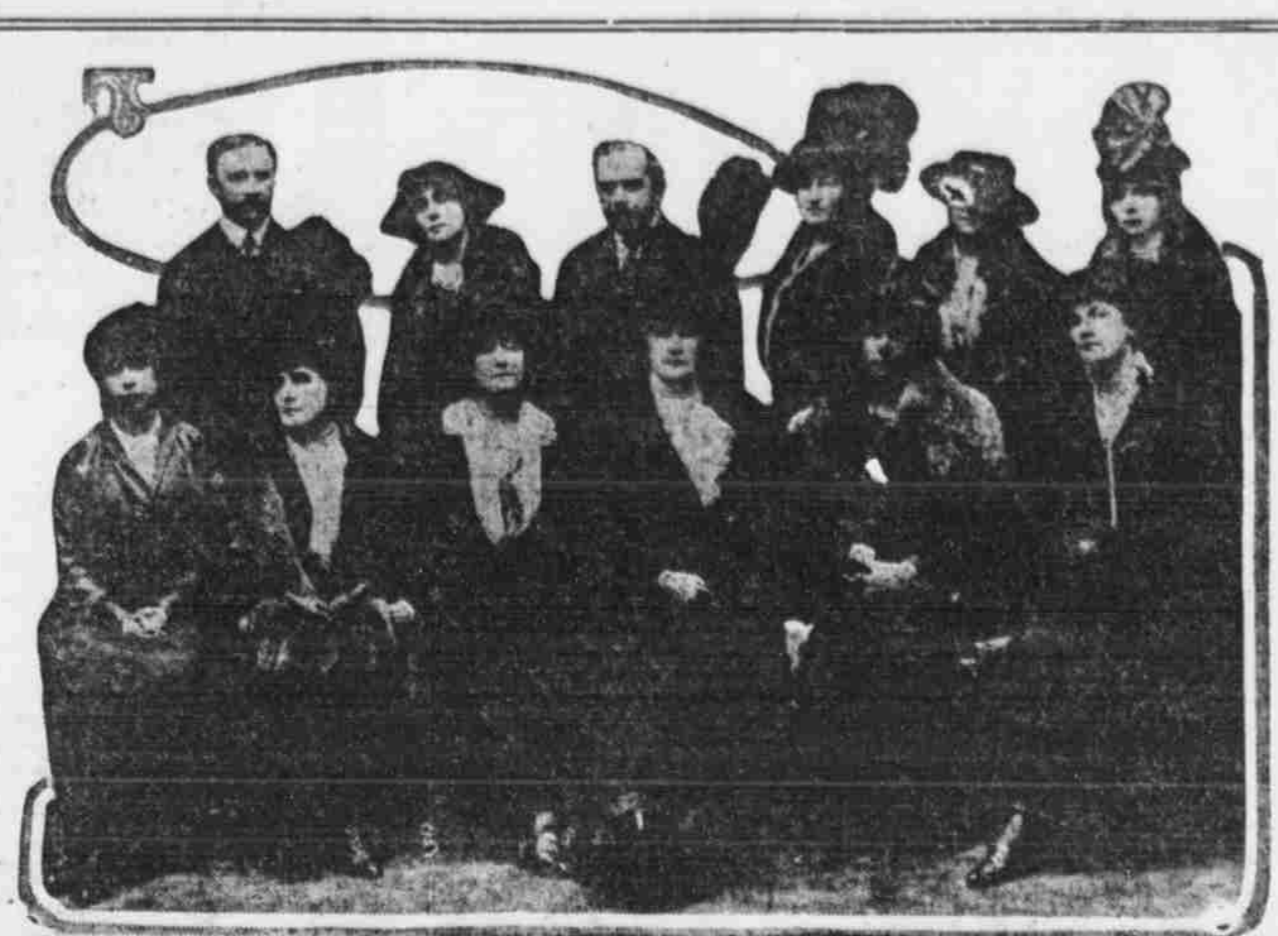

AFFAIRS AT SOUTH OMAHA

Bureau of Animal Industry Hears to West Iowa Quarantine.

EXTREME CARE TO BE USED

Not Case of Foot and Mouth Disease Found in Nebraska, in Spite of the Most Vigilant Search.

Efforts made to have the bureau of animal industry at Washington lift the quarantine on western Iowa have so far proved unavailing, although hope is held out from day to day according to local live stock men.

Quarantine laws on hay have been made less stringent by a recent order which permits hay cut prior to August 1 and baled prior to October 1 to be shipped without reference to quarantine.

Warnings from Washington against men posing as representatives of the government in fighting the foot and mouth disease were officially received at the Union Stock Yards yesterday.
