

READY FOR STOCK TRADING

Dealing on Floor of Exchange to Be Resumed Saturday.

MINIMUM LIST IS GIVEN OUT

Certain Issues Must Not Be Sold Below the Prices Fixed by Governing Committee of the Exchange.

NEW YORK, Dec. 11.—The New York Stock exchange today made public a list of unrestricted stocks, together with minimum prices in the case of restricted stocks, in which trading will be permitted on the floor of the stock exchange beginning tomorrow.

This is the first time that stocks will have been traded in on the floor of the Stock exchange for more than four months, or since July 30 last, when the exchange was closed because of the European situation.
