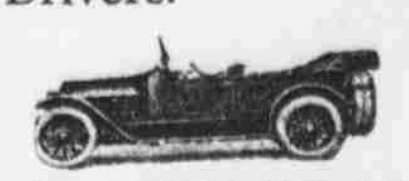

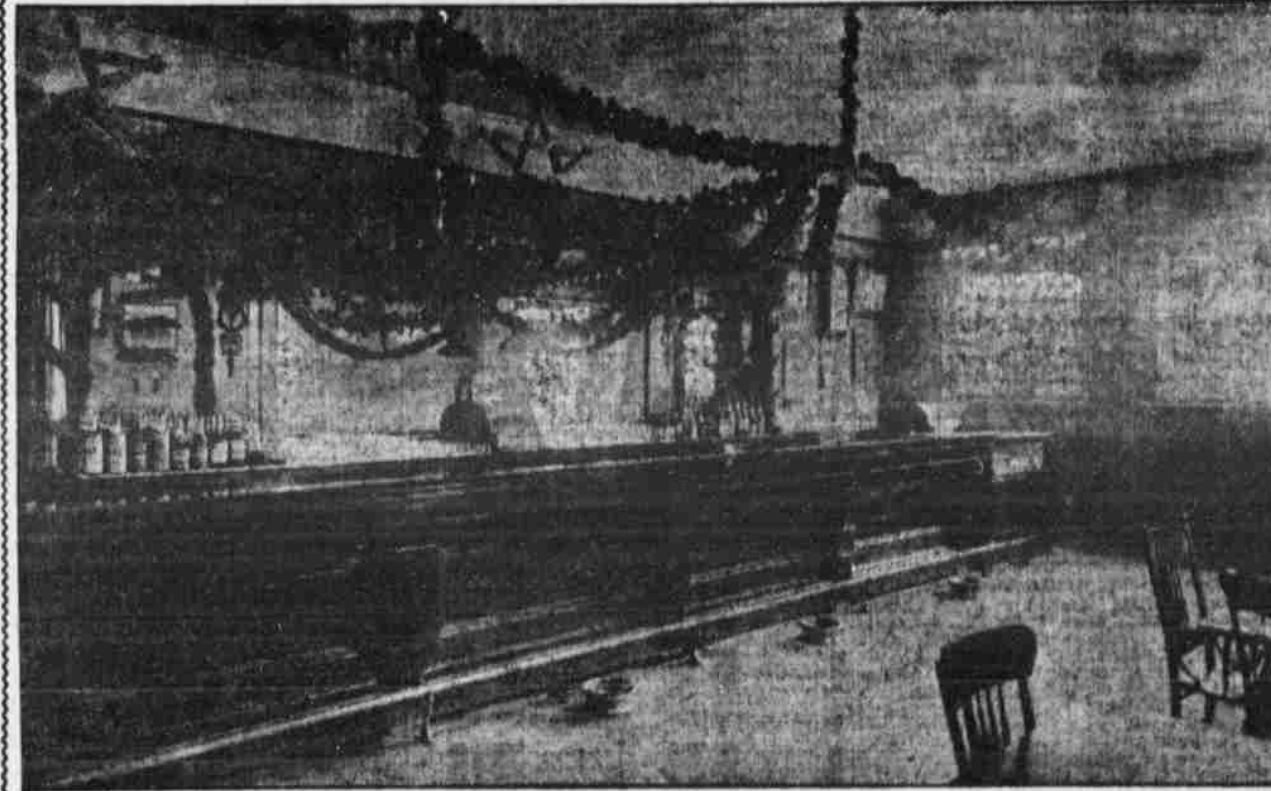

TOKIO, Dec. 18.—(10 p. m.)—Certain British warships have captured those members of the crew of the German cruiser, Emden, which escaped at Cocos Island when the cruiser was destroyed November 16 by the Australian cruiser Sydney. The German sailors went to sea in a Cocos Island schooner named Ayshe.

PRISONERS OF WAR MAY WRITE TO THEIR FAMILIES

(Copyright, 1914, by Press Publishing Co.) LONDON, Dec. 18.—(Special Cablegram to New York World and Omaha Bee)—In an official communication received at the American consulate from the German war office it was stated that there had been some delay in delivering letters and money to prisoners of war because their prisoners of war now total more than 630,000. This communication said this matter had now been thoroughly organized and delay in the future would be reduced. German war officers recently sent to their detention camps a regulation form of postcard with which prisoners could communicate with their families. These cards were printed in six languages. At present all communication between prisoners in either England or Germany is done through the London and Berlin postoffice, the letters passing through ligues without stamps and money orders being forwarded without postage.
