NEW YORK, April 14.—Bethlehem steel was again in the foreground at the opening of today's active stock market. It opened with a sale of 1,000 shares at 128 to 129, an overnight gain of four points, from which it rose mostly in small lots to 140. It then jumped to 145 and as suddenly fell back in breaks of one to three points to 130, all within the first half hour. Elsewhere the market maintained general strength with increased speculative activity.
