COMPLIMENTED ON EFFICIENCY

Resplendent in dress uniforms, Omaha's police force was given its annual inspection and review in front of the city jail Thursday afternoon by Mayor Dahlman, Police Commissioner A. C. Kugel, Commissioners Drexel and Jardine and Chief of Police Henry W. Dunn.

Mayor Dahlman, in his speech following the review, said to the policemen: "We are prouder of you today than we ever have been."

He highly complimented the assembled guardians of the peace upon their splendid appearance, which he said was the outward sign of the efficiency, honesty and loyalty of Omaha's police force.

Less Crime in Omaha. "Our police force is the smallest of any city of Omaha's population in the nation," the mayor said.
