General Assembly Condemns Letter of Dr. Parkhurst

ROCHESTER, N. Y., May 25.—The 17th general assembly of the Presbyterian church of the United States this afternoon adopted a resolution offering supplementary to the report of the temperance committee condemning Rev. Dr. Charles H. Parkhurst of New York for writing a letter to California which was interpreted as supporting the anti-prohibition party of that state. All such letters written by any member under the jurisdiction of the general assembly likewise were condemned.

At the morning session the assembly adopted an overture presented by the Cornish, N. Y., Presbytery, providing for absolute prohibition in any state or territory of the United States. The prohibition would be made effective by an amendment to the constitution of the United States.
