Most Conspicuous Feature of Day's Session is the Extreme Apathy Shown. ALSO PLAINLY PROFESSIONAL

NEW YORK, May 26.—The most conspicuous feature of the New York stock market today was its extreme apathy. Compared with the previous day trading diminished over 50 per cent.

Opening prices were irregular and 1 1/2 to 2 points were maintained. A number of changes, until the afternoon, when gradual recoveries took place in all branches of the list.

Republic Steel common and preferred, Pressed Car Steel, American Can and some of the copper and tin mines advanced 1/2 to 1 point.

Foreign and domestic developments were of a nature to give the market a pessimistic view.

Exchange markets were more steady, this condition applying to sales on Rome as well as London.

Bonds were irregular, with weakness in Rock Island and Wabash issues.

United States bonds advanced 1/2 per cent, and Panama coupon 3/8 on call.

MALONEY SAYS HE BELIEVES GAYNOR

Painter Easily Accounts for His Whereabouts During the Time of the Crime. POLICE STILL ARE BAFLED

"I am firmly convinced that J. M. Gaynor has told us a straight story as accurately as he can recollect what he saw; also all that he knows of events that transpired about the Sykes home Friday, when Ada Swanson was murdered," declared Chief of Detectives Maloney after Mr. Gaynor had come to police headquarters and in detail accounted for the time he had spent upon each portion of the barn which he was painting to the rear of the residence.

The interview with the painter was occasioned by information vouchsafed the police by Rev. A. R. Marshall, 230 Spencer street, president of the Presbyterian Theological seminary, who lives across the street from the Sykes family.

Talks with Gaynor. Dr. Marshall had talked with Gaynor when the man came to work early Friday morning relative to a bit of painting at his home, and shortly after 1 o'clock that afternoon went to the Sykes property to complete arrangements with him about the job.

The fact that he came to the barn on which Gaynor was believed to be working and did not see him led to the painter being asked to account for his whereabouts at this hour. This he did by relating that about the time Marshall called he was in the basement of the Dennis home mixing some paint.

Gaynor declared that he had been in and out of the Dennis basement all day, and therefore could not exactly determine the time of each visit, although he was positive that it was 1 o'clock or shortly after that he made this trip.

After Gaynor and Marshall had left the station Chief Maloney admitted the affair to be decidedly baffling and would vouchsafe no information as to what line the department would now follow on the case.

SCARCITY OF PIGS IS EVIDENT IN IRELAND (Correspondence of the Associated Press.) DUBLIN, May 24.—The decline of pig breeding in Ireland, states a report from the Irish department of agriculture, is due in large part to the want of "housing accommodation" for the animals in the new cottages and the growing disinclination of laborers' families to look after them. The shrinkage in the number of pigs amounts to 30 per cent.

In Ulster, the report states, it is the practice to fatten pigs as soon as they are weaned, and by this means three lots of pigs are turned out in a year. In other parts of the country only one lot is marketed in a year.
