WASHINGTON, Jan. 4.—Representative Gardner, urging his proposal to investigate the military preparedness of the nation, told the house military committee today that the entire field army militia regulars and all of the United States would just about garrison Paris.

Mr. Gardner had a series of lively passages with members of the committee, which he arranged for not summoning Major General Wood and Crozier to get their views on preparedness.
