Dry Goods Market
NEW YORK, Jan. 21.—DRY GOODS.—
Cotton goods were steady and firmer.
Men's wear agents were unable to name
prices for fall, owing to uncertainty in
the market for the coming season.
Representative sales:
SHEEP—Receipts were moderate grain
today, amounting to only 5,000 head com-
pared with 10,000 head last week. The
market for the week to date is 2,700 head,
a shortage of 8,000 head, as compared
with last week, and nearly 11,000 head
less than a year ago.

Shipping orders were very large this
morning, and the market for sheep
shippers buying freely at prices that were
mostly 5c lower, although an occasional
large order was made at a premium. The
shipping trade kept up until nearly all
the best goods, amounting to over half of
the receipts, had been shipped. The ship-
ping orders were made out at \$4.60-5.00;
while packers bought there at \$4.60-5.00;
the long end going at \$5.00, so that the
bulk of all the receipts was at \$4.60-5.00.
Current prices are about 2c lower than Monday,
that being the lowest since the beginning
of the last three days, and are the lowest
since the early part of 1912.

The proportion of ewes was a fifth larger.
As on most days of the week under the
influence of a light supply the market

rather slow start to the trade. Most of
the early sales of ewes and lambs were
at a steady price, with trade active,
but later in the forenoon the market
did not seem so anxious for any
of the early sales, and as a result
prices on both sheep and lambs
closed no better than steady. A large
shipment of lambs moved out at \$2.50
a head, with quite a few few westerns
at \$3.50 and a deck going at \$5.00. The bulk
of the early sales was made at \$3.50-4.00.
There were no wethers or yearlings
available and no feeders to speak of.

Owing to the steady supply this week
prices have shown an advance. Yesterday
and today the bulk of the lambs sold
at \$2.50-3.00, compared with \$2.00-2.50
at the close of last week. The bulk of
