Grain Exchange to Amend Constitution

Members of the Omaha Grain exchange are voting on two changes to the constitution and by-laws of the organization and it is apparent that both amendments

One amendment to the exchange constitution and by-laws provides that the board of directors shall have the power to levy annual dues in such sum as in their judgment is for the best interests of the exchange. Heretofore they have had no such power. The other amendment provides that in the future members

may vote in person, either at a special or regular meeting. The old rule was not clear on the matter of voting.
