GRAIN AND PRODUCE MARKET
Reports Declare Wall Street Has Been Buying May and Selling July for Several Days.
PRICES ARE ABOUT THE SAME

OMAHA, March 10, 1915.
It was the gossip of the wheat pit that Wall street has been buying May and selling July for several days. Commission houses have had considerable new buying and selling from traders who believe that the ultimate scarcity of cash wheat will make higher prices before another crop is shown by present cables that Russia has given the bulk of its grain. It is not all a security for a profit on the part of the speculators.

New York General Market.
NEW YORK, March 10.—SUGAR—Futures opened firmer on scattered covering and buying by the trade interests. Prompted the market price to the spot market, where offerings were smaller. Sugar a middling was 1 1/2 points net higher. Raw steady, centrifugal molasses 2 1/2; refined, steady.

CHICAGO GRAIN AND PROVISIONS
Features of the Trading and Closing Prices on Board of Trade.
CHICAGO, March 10.—Pushes of selling followed one another today in the wheat pit and broke prices at one time 5/8c on account of peace rumors and of reports of a possibly earlier start in the war before neutral were about to give active aid to Great Britain. The market closed unsettled 1/2c to 3/4c under last night. Other net losses were: Corn, 1c to 1 1/2c; oats, 1/2c to 3/4c; and provisions, 2 1/2c.

NEW YORK STOCK MARKET
Opening of Empire State Bids Draws the Attention of Financial Community.

NEW YORK, March 10.—Because of its possible bearing upon investment conditions the attention of the financial community was today drawn largely toward Albany, where bids were opened for the bond issue. Up to the close of the dull and heavy market session no award of a new federal debt was expected. The average of prices bid for the issue was regarded satisfactory. On the curb, which is the market for bonds when issued, the high quotation was 105 3/8.

OTHER INCIDENTS OF THE DAY
The publication of the United States steel tonnage figures in the latter part of the week showed a large increase of about 37,000 tons, which was considerably under general estimates. Incidentally, it is reported that some of the companies submitted statements of earnings for 1914. Lackawanna Steel showed a net profit of \$1,000,000 and the surplus of \$2,000,000 in 1914, and the surplus of the steel-Riverside steel company exceeded considerable depreciation in 1914.
