ROURKES WIN BOOSTER PRAY

Reisigl Passes Krueger to Get Chance at Tipple, Who Hits.
OMAHA THEN STARTS PARADE
Mates Follow Tipple's Example and Bombard Reisigl and Grover for Thirteen Hits and Win Booster Battle, 11 to 1.

Mr. Jack Reisigl, member of the Austrian nobility who has deserted his native land in the time of crisis to act as chief ruffian in the nut organization from Topeka, intentionally passed Hattie Krueger in the fifth inning of yesterday's booster battle which didn't boost, to get a chance at Daniel Tipple, the well known pulchritudinous athlete.
