GRAIN AND PRODUCE MARKET

Enormous Increase in Visible Supply of Cash Wheat is Shown.

FOREIGNERS ARE GOOD BUYERS Londing Up on Heavy Shipments of Cereals-Corn Shows Considerable Irregularity in

Price.

OMAHA. Sept. 22. Bit.

An enormous increase for the week in the visible supply of wheat, both in this country and Canada, was shown yesterday and the trade was somewhat taken aback. A total increase of 11,169,000 bushels for North America caused a large quentity of wheat to be dumped upon the market yesterday and broke prices sharply from the high points. The movement of wheat promises to let down, however, according to all indications in fact, receipts at primary markets yesterday were materially lighter than for the corresponding day last week. Farmers are inclined to hold for better prices and the showery weather that prevailed in sections of the northwest yesterday is not conductive to free marketing. However, wheat stocks at Minneapolis already show an increase of 1,00,000 bushels since Friday last, compared with an increase of 350,000 bushels for the corresponding period last year.

The wheat imarket aere yesterday was a nervous affair, featured by rapid price fluctuation. Resting spots for the active futures were be higher than Saturday's final, while the September delivery closed at the first was seed hoving early and the setter. The trade on beef steers was slow and late in opening, largely due to the fact that some of the trains were late in arriving in the yards, and that it took some little time to get shaped up and ready to be shown. When the trade was finally under way prices ranged anywhere from steady on some of the best, to loc lower on some of the less desirable kinds. There was nothing very choice with which to make a top, but there were cornfed steers good enough to bring \$9.75, with westerns at \$8.75. Cows and heifers were in about the same condition as beef steers except that it was the common grades or canners

Eight dollars and thirty-rive central proved to be the most popular price, although there was a good showing of heavies and the more common mixed stuff around \$8.30 and \$8.32½; Shipping hogs moved anywhere from a quarter to as much as 50c above the killers, best lights selling as high as as \$8.50.

Today's average is just about the same as Saturday's, but prices have been uneven, and while shippers are some higher for the week, packing grades are selling at figures that are right close to a nickel off.

SHEEP—The last sales of lambs on Monday's market averaged 75c lower than the close of last week, with trade lasting until late in the day, and about a dozen loads being carried over for today's market. The general run of aged sheep offerings yenterday showed a decline of 40 \$60c from last Friday, and while feeder lambs were generally 19215c lower there was little if any change in feeder sheep, there being very few feeder yearlings, wethers and ewes available.

Monday's big run was followed by another this morning, as the receipta amounted to some 40,000 head, against \$1,000 a week ago and 45,000 on the same day a year ago. Chicago was reported as having only 28,000. The bulk of the local offerings consisted of lambs, and the general quality of both sheep and lambs was lacking, there being not one choice bunch of fat lambs in the barn. Feeder buyers had a liberal supply to fill orders from.

The packer buyers started out on their first rounds early as compared with the standstill trade yesterday, and apparently wanted some good killers. They bought such lambs as were on sale in good season in the forenoon, paying prices for fat lambs generally steady to a dime lower and about steady for the light supply of mutton.
