As has been the rule for several days real shipping hogs were searce, and shippers and speculators had to fill their liberal orders with fair to good mixed hogs, which they bought at prices that were in most cases steady with yesterday. Packers were indifferent again this morning and made their first offers at a flat dime decline. Salesmen asked steady to strong prices, but even with the shippers buying freely killer bids failed to strengthen up to any great extent, and when the bulk of the supply finally started to move packers purchases were fully \$660c, and in most cases nearly 16c lower. Movement, while not active, was fairly continuous, and a fair clearance was made by a reasonable hour.
