Since the bureau has been opened the two telephones have been ringing almost constantly, and persons have listed rooms rapidly. Most of them are willing to serve breakfast also, which is much desired by the Ak-Sar-Ben authorities.

In most cases the prices listed are 50 to 75 cents per hour for sleeping quarters and 25 cents for breakfast.

Because it is becoming more and more of a custom to drive to Omaha in automobiles for Ak-Sar-Ben, this bureau is also collecting a list of garages that will have accommodations for the machines at night.
