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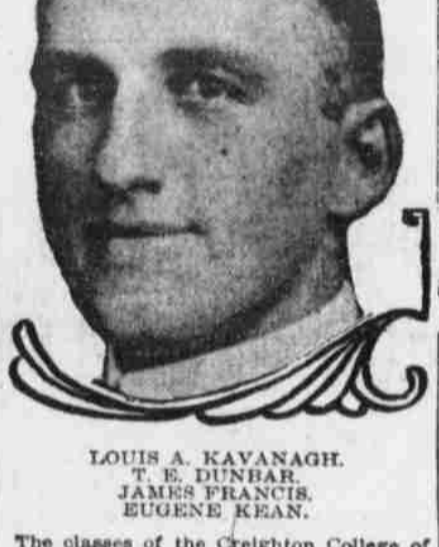

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Omaha Banks Will Help Out on Gold Pool Being Made Up

Omaha banks will send their quota of gold to the gold pool being made up in Washington to meet American obligations in Europe.

At a meeting of the Omaha Clearing House association yesterday afternoon it was decided to comply with this request of the regional reserve board.

Omaha banks were asked to contribute \$750,000 to the fund. Only 25 per cent of this is required immediately.

"It is even possible that not all of the \$750,000 will ever need to be sent," said J. C. French, president of the Omaha Clearing House association.

At any rate we will not be required to send the next installment until the proceeds of the first can be returned to us in some form of exchange.
