John F. Van Scoyoc Buried at Louisville

Remains Brought Back to Boyhood Home Here for Interment—Masons in Charge.

The funeral of the late John Frederick Van Scoyoc, of Lincoln, occurred at Louisville on Thursday afternoon, September 26th, at River View cemetery, following a service in Lincoln at the Hodgman funeral parlors, conducted by the Rev. G. A. Gies. The services at the grave were very beautiful and impressive, being conducted by the Masonic lodge, of Springfield. The deceased had been a member of the A. F. & A. M. for a good many years.

Mr. Van Scoyoc was born at Winterset, Iowa, February 13, 1868. He moved to Louisville with his parents at the age of ten years. In the year 1891, he entered the service of the Burlington railroad and was an engineer for 25 years and was in the Burlington service 33 years and stood high in the service.

He was married November 10, 1896, to Miss Corna Wright, a son of Carl and a daughter, Ruth, were born to them who, with the widow, survive him. He was a member of the Masonic lodge No. 54, of Lincoln, and also held a membership in the Brotherhood of Locomotive Engineers, Division No. 98. Because of ill health two years ago, he retired from the Burlington as engineer and after patient suffering departed this life on September 23, 1929, at the age of 61 years, 7 months and 19 days.

Mr. Van Scoyoc was well known and remembered here. He was a man of high principles, good character, kind heart and was a splendid citizen, a devoted husband and father and he will be greatly missed by his family and large circle of friends.

The wealth of floral offerings testified to the high regard in which the deceased and his family are held. Mr. Van Scoyoc also leaves a sister, Mrs. Harry Green, of Lincoln, and four brothers, Charles, William, Leroy and Darwin Van Scoyoc.—Louisville Courier.

ARREST PHEASANT HUNTERS

Several early pheasant hunters had their activities curtailed and sustained severe financial jolts when deputy game wardens, acting under instructions from Chief Game Warden O'Connell arrested them. Dr. M. J. Healy of Omaha was arrested at Schuyler upon information furnished by Ed Schultz, a farmer residing in that vicinity and was fined \$25 with costs totaling \$2.60, together with \$10 liquidated damages to the state. Otto Empfield of Stapleton was fined \$25 and costs for shooting pheasants out of season. Clements Darandus of Aurora was fined \$25 and costs together with \$10 damages. Julius Hall of Kenesaw had his gun confiscated and was fined \$25 and costs, plus \$10 damages. George Ott and Raymond Heath of South Sioux City were fined \$1 and costs each for hunting without a permit.
