RUMORS QUEEN MAY WED
London—The Vienna correspondent of the Daily Express says it is widely reported in Bucharest society circles that Queen Helen, divorced wife of King Carol of Rumania, is planning to marry a Rumanian officer, Colonel Skeletti.
The Express report is connected with the queen's adamant refusal to become reconciled with Carol. She is reported to have written him that she will reject any attempt on his part to have their divorce nullified by court proceedings. The divorce was declared null and void by the holy synod of the Rumanian orthodox church shortly after Carol became king last June, but it was explained that this made it only morally nonexistent, as legal annulment would have to come thru the courts.

RIVER HEARING AT YANKTON FEB. 20
Yankton, S. D., Feb. 13.—Capt. Theodore Wyman, Army engineer, will be in Yankton Feb. 20 for a hearing on the proposal to have the War department improve the Missouri river for navigation as far north as Williston, N. D., and to maintain a barge line on the river.
According to officers of the Yankton Chamber of Commerce, who are working on the proposition, it must be established at the hearing, before action will be taken, that persons would be directly affected by the barge lines must favor the project, and that there is evidence of sufficient tonnage to warrant maintenance of navigability and a barge line.
