

# Wedding Brings Charges of Parole Being Violated

### Former Plattsmouth Young Man Is One of Those Charged with This Offense at Omaha.

A young man and a girl were held in jail at Omaha Friday, wanted by two states because they got married—but not to each other—in violation of their paroles. They are Mrs. Helen Tallman Meyer, 20, former Wyoming teacher and summer school student of the University of Wyoming, and Orval Denson, 27, of 925 1/2 North Twenty-fourth street, Omaha.

Mrs. Meyer married Henry Meyer, Midwest, Wyo., rancher, while she was on parole from a girls' school at Sheridan.

Denson a week ago last night married Hope Darling Herman, 21, while on parole after serving one year of a one to two-year sentence for forgery at the Nebraska penitentiary. Both are awaiting return to prison.

Mrs. Meyer told reporters that at 17 she rebelled against the strict discipline of her parents, living in Cheyenne, who wouldn't let her go out as much as she would have liked. As a result she was sent to the Sheridan school. For good behavior, she was released on parole eight months ago. Later she attended the teachers' school at the state university, then obtained a position as teacher at MidWest.

Here she met a good looking young rancher, Henry Meyer, and fell in love with him.

"I don't believe the state would be so cruel as to send you back for following the dictates of your heart," said the rancher.

Helen believed him. They eloped to Gering, Neb., and were married, January 31. They returned to the ranch. Then Henry sent his wife for a visit to her grandfather's home in Omaha. Here she was arrested.

"Isn't love, marriage and a home the ideal of every state?" she asked, as she sat in jail. "Why should a state cause my arrest because I wanted a home and happiness?"

Orval Denson is asking the same question. So is his bride.

Denson had an excellent record in prison. Paroled to his brother in Plattsmouth, he got a job and was employed in Omaha at the time of his recent arrest.

He has become a Bible student and was, until his arrest, attending Bible school three times a week.

His mother said she would seek her church's aid to keep Orval from going back to prison.

"How can he be good in prison?" she asked. "Prison will embitter his heart and soul, which he has given to God. It will undo all the good that is in him now."—World-Herald.
