WARREN STARTS ON DECADE Goes to Lincoln for Ten Years Without Credit for Time Spent in Jail. Joseph Warren, convicted of the robbery

of Nels Lausten's saloon on the night Lausten was murdered, was taken to the penitentiary Thursday morning to begin his ten-year sentence. The supreme court after refusing a rehearing of his case also refused to date the sentence back from the time of his conviction, over a year ago, but will require him to serve ten years from the date of him delivery to the penitentiary. T. A. Hollister, his attorney, asked the court to give Warren credit on his sentence for the time he has been in jail since his arrest a year ago last January. He has just been notified of the refusal of the court to do this.
