

FAT STOCK SHOW IN OMAHA

Next Big Enterprise Which is to Be Landed.

COMMISSION MEN ARE IN ON IT

National Live Stock Association May Follow Up with Meeting, Both to Be Held at the Auditorium.

Now for a fat stock show in Omaha, followed, perhaps, by meetings of the National Live Stock Association and other stock men's conventions.

Within a few weeks a meeting is to be called at the Commercial club and one of the preliminary steps for a fat stock show to be held in the Auditorium during the fall of 1908. It will be a show which will interest the stock growers of seven states and will include a display of horses, cattle, hogs, sheep and it is planned to hold the poultry show in connection, making it at once one of the most complete displays of commercial animals and poultry in the west.

Omaha is advantage point for the fat stock show and before next year a circuit will be formed which will include Denver, Omaha, Kansas City and Chicago. Denver has given fat stock shows and secured national conventions of stockmen, though it is not recognized in the same class as Omaha as a live stock market.

Judson the Spokesman. F. W. Judson, manager of the Midland Glass and Paint company and one interested in live stock for many years, will present the subject at a meeting of business men of Omaha and South Omaha, which is to be held at the Commercial club, Mr. Judson said.

"Following the stock show Omaha will show an interest in the business which will cause the national conventions of stockmen to select this city as a meeting place. We are always represented at the meetings, but we have not had one here. It is strange that one of the three large live stock markets of America should not have a live stock show, when thousands interested in the business come to Omaha many times a year. It seems that the time is ripe for the consideration of the stock show business, and we have a whole year in which to make the arrangements."

Mr. Judson has the backing of the large live stock interests of South Omaha in his proposal that Omaha make the stock show the big feature of next fall and winter's entertainments which are furnished each year for the patrons of the market and the friends of the city. A number of Wyoming and western Nebraska stockmen have inquired lately why it was that Omaha did not have a fat stock show and the business men propose to see that no opportunity for a display is lost.

ONLY ONE ARREST OF KIND

Plan of Chief and Mayor in Dealing with Sabbath Laws is to Secure Tests.

Chief of Police Donahue after consultation with the mayor has made tentative arrangements for the enforcement of the Sunday closing order which is to become effective December 15. It has been decided to give the citizens an opportunity to test the scope and intent of the law in the courts, hence but one person in each line of business will be arrested until after the courts pass upon the matter.

Under this plan in case of violations, one newsboy, one newspaper carrier, one employe of a theater, one grocer, one butcher, one druggist, one cigar dealer, and so on, will be taken into custody and be given a chance to appeal from conviction before others are arrested. If the first man taken should be acquitted, or should refuse to appeal from conviction another will be arrested until one can be found in each line of work who will give the supreme court an opportunity to pass upon the statute.

As the arrests are being made under the terms of a state law, and not of a city ordinance, Mayor Dahlman is trying to find a way by which cost of prosecution can be shifted from the city to the state or county. If possible under the law suits against violators of the statute will be brought before a justice of the peace or the county judge in place of before the police magistrate.

FIGHT TO STOP STOCK YARDS

Injunction Sought by Ice Plant Against North Pacific at North Platte.

The hearing upon the application for an injunction to restrain the Union Pacific Railroad company from constructing stock yards at North Platte was heard before Judge W. H. Munger in the United States circuit court Saturday morning. The plaintiff in the case is John Frazier who operates an ice plant in the vicinity of the proposed new stock yards. The application for an injunction is based upon the allegation that the spring from which the plaintiff procures his supply of spring water for the operation of his ice plant will run through the proposed stock yards and by the establishment of such yards the water will become polluted and the business of the plaintiff thereby destroyed.
