Next Saturday's Game with Iowa Big Contest of Season.

FOR STATE CHAMPIONSHIP HONOR

Work of Two New Coaches Will Be Tested in Contest of Absorbing Interest—Merits of Opposing Teams.

IOWA CITY, Ia., Nov. 18.—(Special.)—The State University of Iowa football team will meet the representatives of the State Agricultural college at Ames on November 23 in a contest which will decide the championship of the state of Iowa.

In the nine games played Ames has won three and lost five, one game remaining unfinished. By virtue of the victory last year Ames secured the undisputed championship of the state.
