

GRAND JURY SCORES JAIL

Denounces Unsanitary Condition as Worse Than Libby Prison.

LIKED TO HOG PEN ALSO

Sheriff and His Force Blameless, the Responsibility Falling on the Size and Inadequacy of the Building.

Declaring if the people of Douglas county and Omaha knew the condition existing at the county jail they would rise up and demand that the authorities do something to relieve the situation.

The report is signed by all sixteen of the jurors and is the result of a visit the grand jury made to the jail last week.

After telling of the visit to the jail the report continues:

It is with shame and regret that we find it necessary to report that everything pertaining to the jail and the prisoners is in the most deplorable, miserable and disgusting condition.

The jail is in all respects unsanitary. Upon entering we were greeted with a nauseous, stifling odor that was positively sickening.

We found that it is necessary to require six men to sleep in a small cell scarcely large enough for one.

The result of all this is that prisoners confined here a short time appear sickly and pale.

We desire to assert, however, that the sheriff and his assistants are in no wise at fault for the conditions here.

The members of this grand jury feel confident that whenever the citizens of Douglas county become familiar with the conditions herein faintly described they will not only sanction the erection of a new jail, but will demand that those in authority immediately take steps to bring this about.

LAW ON SALE OF FIRE ARMS Ordinance by Brucker Contemplates Drawing Tighter Lines.

SPOT MAN WHO BUYS THE WEAPON Compel Dealer to Hold License and Take Name and Address of Purchaser So as to Keep Watch.

Providing for a system of permits and certificates to be signed by both the seller and the purchaser of small firearms, Councilman G. F. Brucker is working on a more stringent provision governing the carrying of concealed weapons.

According to the provisions of the new ordinance which the councilman from the Fifth ward is working on, every dealer in small firearms must procure a license from the city before he can dispose of his wares.
