Half That Amount in Sales Closed in One Day.

REST DUE DURING THE WEEK

Agents Are Busy Supplying Demands for Homes to Omaha and Nebraska Parties with Money.

Sales of Omaha real estate were closed by various dealers Tuesday aggregating more than \$200,000.

The fact that cash is being paid for almost every home and few mortgages are going on record is further evidence of the better than normal condition which Omaha business men are enjoying and the demand for good real estate investments.

The Robert Haaker home in Dundas has been sold to W. E. Shepherd, cashier of the Nebraska National bank.

William B. Money has bought the lot near Pacific avenue and Hickory streets, facing Hanson park, from Jacob Williams for \$2,000 and will build a home costing from \$4,500 to \$5,000.

J. L. Maurer has sold his property at Twenty-fourth and Franklin streets to L. C. Butler for \$6,000 and a lot with home at Forty-first avenue and Decatur street for \$2,500, making a cash deal of \$3,000.

Five Thousand for Home. Frank Dimas has bought the Charles W. Martin home at Fifteenth and Emmet streets for \$5,000.

The same firm has sold ten acres north of Dundas to Fritz Koch of Emerson, who will make his home on the tract, moving here from his farm in northeastern Nebraska.

Leo Baroch has sold a home at Ninth and Hickory streets to H. P. Fremont for \$2,000.

Louis Janssen, formerly of Omaha, has returned from Brooklyn, N. Y., to buy ten acres north of Dundas from the Russell ranch for \$5,000.

Hale & Lochboeher have sold their bakery business, generally known as the Connecticut Pie Factory, at 321 Grant street for \$4,500 to Jay Burns, who also bought residence property at Twenty-first and Brown streets from the same firm for \$7,000.

BURBANK FOR THE CORN SHOW

Wizard of California Will Be Asked by G. W. Wattles to Come to Omaha.

Luther Burbank, wizard of agriculture and horticulture, maker of varieties of fruits and plants, and remodeler of the vegetable kingdom, may be induced to give a series of exhibitions at the Omaha Corn show.

Mr. Burbank has never demonstrated the methods by which he has made some tasteless fruits delicious, some small potatoes to grow the size of watermelons and otherwise improved fruits and vegetables, but there is hope he will participate in the national show at Omaha.

G. W. Wattles has written from Southern California to the management of the Corn Show association, saying that he will see Mr. Burbank at his home in Pasadena within a few days and try to secure the wizard to come to the Omaha show.

Mr. Wattles has hopes that he will succeed and Luther Burbank will be able to give information to the visitors to the national show such as can be given by few students and experimenters with plant life.

The show is receiving daily endorsements from specialists in agriculture from all parts of the United States. Prof. J. Wilkes Jones will arrive in Omaha Wednesday enroute to the meeting of the Nebraska Editorial association at Lincoln.

FLAXSEED FOR BREAKFAST

New Food and Universal Medicine is to Be Made by Douglas County Farmer.

L. Coltrin has returned from Chicago, Battle Creek and Indianapolis, where he says he has invested \$40,000 in machinery for the manufacture of his "Cereal Steam Breakfast Food," and anti-dyspeptic preparation, containing flax seed, whole wheat and celery.

When Mr. Coltrin showed the food, which he has patented to the specialists at Battle Creek, they offered to annex it to the gastrointestinal repertoire of their food factories and pay \$200,000 for the patents of the Omaha. But Mr. Coltrin refused the offer and sought machinery with which to mix his flax seed and wheat into a food which will act as a universal medicine and when mixed with cream and sugar, be as delicious as pommes de terre, fruit cake, and not involve a trip to Calistad at the end of a few years.

Mr. Coltrin is enthusiastic over his new enterprise, after being a successful Douglas county farmer for more than twenty years, and will invest in equipping the plant to make breakfast food and advertise Omaha as the home of the great cereal health-giver.
