ing contralto singing which is too much heard nowadays, her voice was not darkened with a hard asphalitic style of tone production.
As Pinkerton Mr. Kurt Donath offered some interesting problems in the art of tone production. His method is singular, and not the least singular thing about it is the ease and certainty with which he can at times pour forth "B flats" although they were more nothing. His male voice is uncertain, sometimes carrying well and sometimes not at all. He gave the part of Pinkerton a subdued portrayal.

Mr. Donath conducted in the afternoon with Teutonic power and the orchestra was beautiful in the softer work, but too loud in many of the accompaniments.
In the evening the title role was played by Miss Phoebe Strakosch, who shows an aptitude for dramatic work in the first part of the second act. The part is the most diversified, probably in the whole history of opera. It runs through almost every shade of experience possible to woman. Miss Strakosch was alive to most of these points. She has that "clucking" sound technically known as the "stroke" of the "glottis." Miss Strakosch developed wonderfully from shortly after her first entrance.

Miss Ethel Houston as Pearl poured forth luscious tones from a free and flexible vocal apparatus. Her singing and her acting were well up and the pronunciation of each of these two women was clearly itself. In fact, distinct pronunciation was the rule of the evening, as it is the tocsin of the Savages regime.
Mr. Vernon Stiles gave a magnificent presentation of Pinkerton. He really idealized the part, a difficult thing to do. He looked handsome, acted with a keen appreciation of the possibilities of each situation, his voice was large and glorious and not a syllable of what he said was lost. He has certainly developed with great strides since he was heard here with the old Bostonians.

He has a fine second in Mr. Otley Cranston, who played the couple with just poise and living dignity. His dressing of the part seemed more adequate to the part than that usually seen. His voice and singing were also finely adequate.
Miss Rauffsch and Miss Emilie Cole handled the minor part of Kate Pinkerton with satisfactory results.
Mr. Rothwell conducted at night and gave beautiful effects with frequency. He has the orchestra entirely in his grasp and his sense is poetic and thoroughly artistic.
The lighting effects and the general working out of the stage pictures and of the scenic splendor were of course all that could be desired. And when one sees the practice and remembers the artist and the chorus and the orchestra and the composer, the wonderful Puccini, he must not forget the story teller, John Luther Long.
