We furnished the re quired cortificates and they were properly certified by the auditor of public accounts of Nebraska. But the California commissioner has made various excuses and delayed action on the documents submitt d The Nebraska department has always accepted the certificates of the California imissioner and issued licenses to the insurance companies on them. The insurance department of Nebraska requested the California department to join in making an examination of the documents and statements submitted, but this was not done prior to January 31, 1908, when the licenses of the California companies expired. The reciprocal law of Nebraska then became operative and until California recognizes the insurance department and companies of Nebraska, there will be nothing doing for the California companies in this state.
