Dr. B. Schelling Dead. Dr. B. Schelling, the emergency physician of the Cudahy Packing plant, died yesterday at his home near Gilmore.

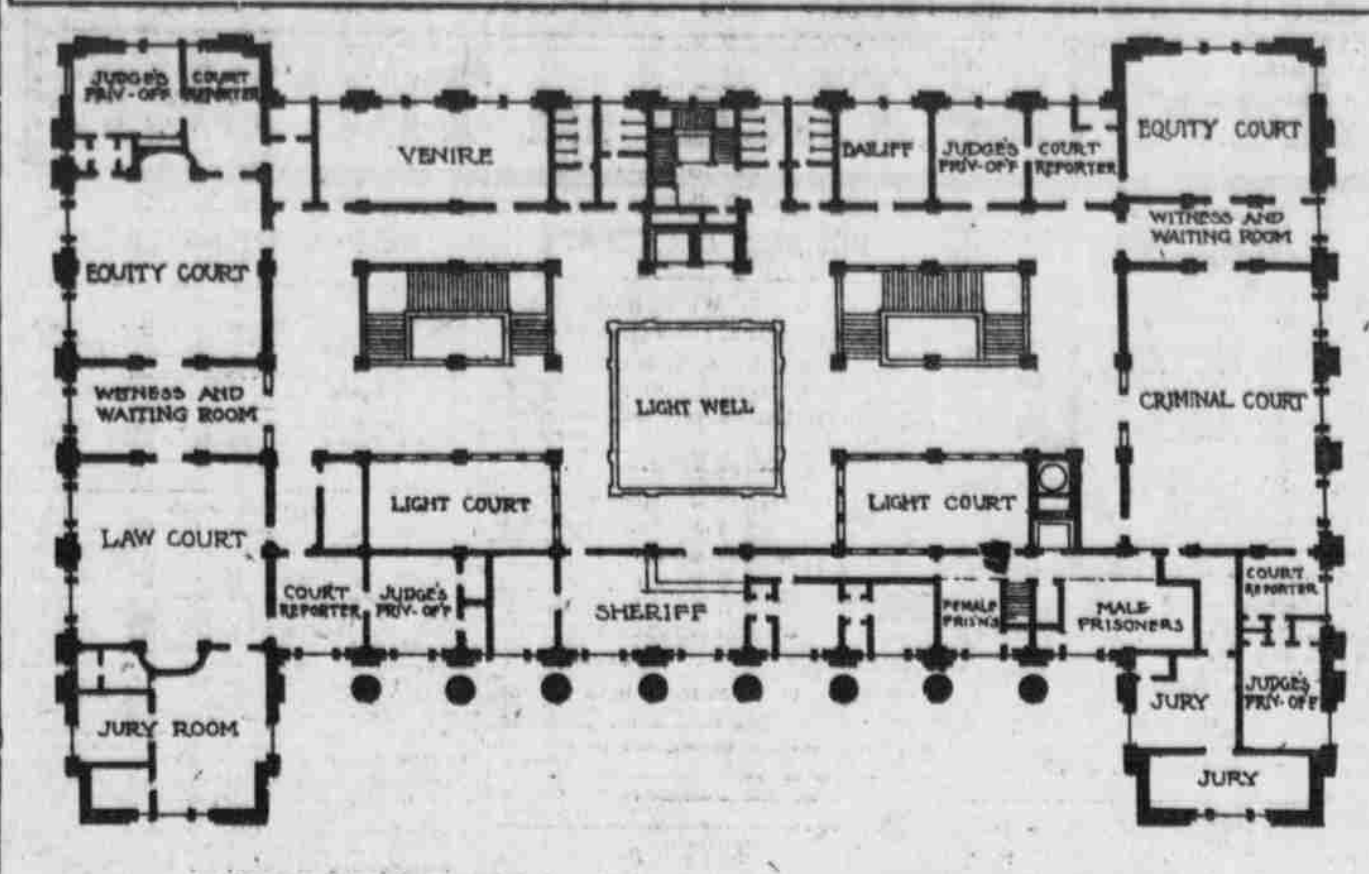

FOREIGNERS IN COLLEGE HERE

Students from All Over the World in This Country.

It is apparently only in the last few years that there has been any marked disposition on the part of foreigners to come to American universities.

Two years ago Dr. Rudolf Tombo, Jr., registrar of Columbia, made up a table to show the foreign student population.

In the table of two years ago Columbia had 117 foreign students; Cornell, 100; Harvard, 94; Yale, 81; and Princeton, 20.
