WARING TELLS OF WRECK
Says One Rail of Track Was Torn Up and Thrown Far Into a Corn Field.
Henry M. Waring, reporter in Judge Redick's court, yesterday told the story of the wreck of the Rock Island near Alvo Sunday morning, when he was able to be at his desk Monday, though he was still stiff and sore from his experience. His only injury was two cuts on the left leg between the knee and the hip, received from an iron spike which struck him. Four stitches were taken in one of the cuts at Lincoln. "We were running at a terrific rate of speed," said Mr. Waring, "and the train left the track on a sharp curve. I realized something was wrong before our car left the track and started to reach for an anchor to hold on to. Before I could do so our car hit the ties and began to turn over. I was thrown against the window and my leg came in contact with the jagged pane of glass. "The rate of speed at which the train was running can be ascertained from the fact that one of the rails was torn loose from the ties and thrown clear up over the telegraph wire, lighting in a cornfield seven rows of corn back from the fence. The wires still bore signs of contact with the rail, one of them being cut almost in two. One man in the car was cooled and doused with cold water. The cooler glistened from his head and struck another passenger in the back."
