

OSCAR CALLS SWEDES HOME

King Thus Seeks to Improve Industrial Conditions.

VIEW OF PLAN DIFFER HERE

N. P. Swanson Thinks It Will Fail Because the Swedish-Americans Could Not Adopt Old Country Ways.

Considerable difference of opinion is expressed by Swedes in Omaha regarding the probable effect of the new information bureau established in the United States by order of King Oscar of Sweden...

This bureau is of official character, although backed by private individuals in Sweden. Sweden is experiencing the effect of the large emigration which has taken place in recent years...

Return to the Native Land. The reported intention of the committee is to have many Swedes who are not satisfied with their conditions in America return to their native land...

Speaking of this desire and the request for information, N. P. Swanson, who has recently returned from a trip to Sweden, said:

"I do not think any attempt to attract Swedes from America will succeed. Many of the immigrants came here when they were young and while they maintain the use of their native language, their customs are American and they can no more adapt themselves to Swedish ways than can any person foreign to the soil..."

Another View of It. John Hendrickson, 322 California street, was of a different opinion:

"I think the movement will meet with a considerable degree of success. Sweden is booming and there is a comparatively large number of people who have returned from the United States and have made more money in Sweden than they could have made here..."
