## NEBRASKANS IN THE RING

La Follette's List Includes Morton, Kreh and Dawes.

## ARE AMONG PANIC MAKERS NOW

Once Modest Nebraskans Go East and Get Into the Senator's Exclusive List of One Hundred.

When Senator La Follette made public the names of the men who he said, in an argument against the Aldrich currency bill, in the senate control of the industrial life of the nation, not an Omaha million-

aire was mentioned, but three former Nebraskans broke into the senator's catalogue of panic makers.

They are Paul Morton, formerly of Nebraska City; A. W. Kreh, of Omaha, and Charles G. Dawes of Lincoln.

Bankers of Omaha looked in vain to find the name of a Nebraskan who lives in the state at present among those who it is said "make periods of depression at will," and the president of one of the banks remarked:

"We might not have panic makers in Omaha now, but we have some twenty or thirty men in Omaha who can break a panic and its effects. If it took the entire list given by Senator La Follette to make the recent panic, it took only a few Omahans—with the help of the people—ward off the effects of the panic."

Paul Morton is now president of the Equitable Life Assurance Society. The story of his entrance into the railroad, financial and political world is well known. His father was the late J. Sterling Morton, and Paul Morton grew to young manhood at Arbor Lodge, near Nebraska City. From the vice presidency of the Santa Fe railroad he went to a place in the cabinet of President Roosevelt, presiding over the Department of Navy, and after the insurance troubles of New York was elected to the presidency of the insurance company. In his present position he is considered by the senator from Wisconsin as one of those who has the power to "raise and lower prices of commercial prices at will, force the farmers to sell into the hands of speculators and artificially relieve money stringencies."

Charles G. Dawes was formerly a Lincoln lawyer and civil engineer, living there from 1857 to 1894. Then he went into the gas business at Evanston, Ill.; La Crosse, Wis., and Akron, O. He was the chief executive of the McKinley movement in Illinois and a member of the republican national committee in 1896 and became comptroller of the currency in 1897.

A. W. Kreh was special master during the receivership of the Union Pacific railroad and made his home in Omaha.

T. J. Coolidge, one of those in Senator La Follette's list, was formerly president of the Burlington railroad and is known in Omaha.
